

IMPORTANT NOTICE

In order to give the best possible service to our clients and the shortest possible turnaround times on your application, you must submit all documentation that you wish to have considered in assessing your application.

The application must include:

1. Proof of relationship to your host in Canada.

- This can take the form of the birth certificate of your host, the original matriculation certificate or original fifth class certificate of your host.

2. Proof of funds for both yourself and the host in Canada.

- **HOST:** Most Recent Notice of Assessment from the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA), Most Recent T4 Slips, Most Recent Employment Letters from your host's employer in Canada
- **APPLICANT:** Indian Income Tax documents, letters of employment ongoing bank balances for the past 6 months. Ongoing bank balances for the past 6 months of FDs and term deposits and provident funds, any proof of liquid assets you wish to submit.

3. Proof of status for your host in Canada

- This can take the form of a copy of the PR Card, copy of IMM 1000 (landing document) or Confirmation of Permanent Residence (CPR), or passport, or Citizenship Card etc

You may wish to submit any other relevant additional documents to have your application assessed. Your application will be reviewed/assessed on the information submitted, by an Immigration Officer at the Consulate General of Canada.

Your application may be refused without further requests for information.
